

Annall family of Well & Snape, North Yorkshire (1741-1909)



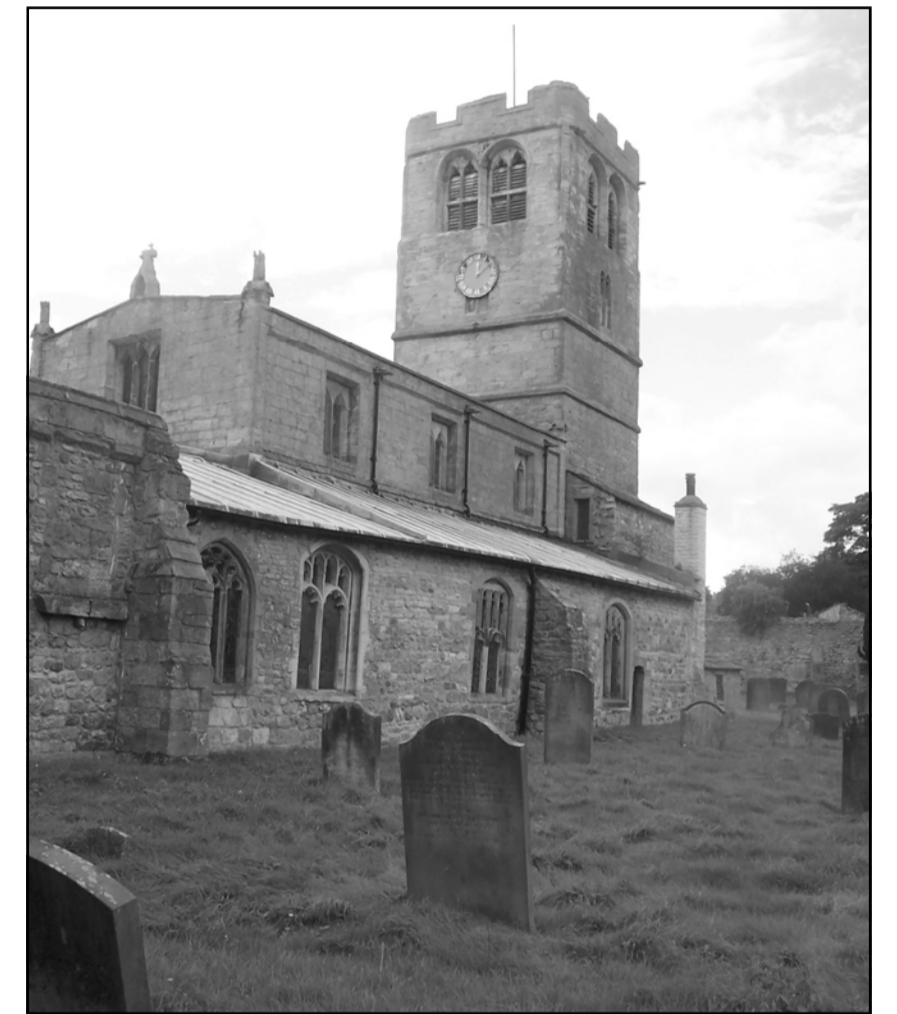
Gravestone of Thomas ANNALL (317904) in Well parish churchyard

William JAMES married secondly, Elizabeth BUCKLE on 30 October 1806. He was buried at Well in August 1829 and his will was proved on 9 March 1830 at the Archdeaconry Court of Richmond. The executor was his widow, Elizabeth, who had since married William ANNALL (317901). This William was the nephew of Anne ANNALL, the son of her brother Robert (317891).

The Well parish registers record the burial of an Elizabeth ANNALL on 14 December 1750. This is possibly an error for Bridget.

This baptism was found on the IGI. There's no real evidence that it's the right Elizabeth MIDDLETON but the location and the father's name suggest that it probably is.
